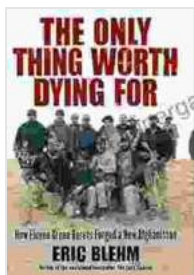


How Eleven Green Berets Fought For New Afghanistan

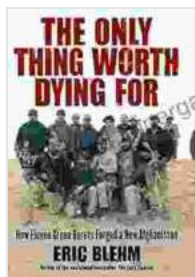
