


The RMS Lusitania: A Tragic Tale of Torpedo and Sinking

Wartime Shadow

With the outbreak of World War I in 1914, the Lusitania's role shifted from passenger service to transporting war supplies to Great Britain. Fatal Voyage



Panic and Chaos




A tragic sight as the once-mighty ship disappears below the waves.

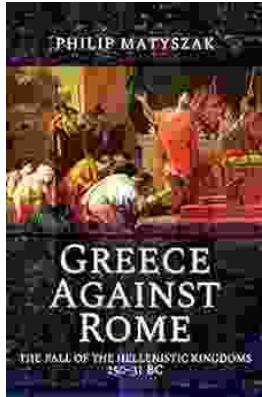
